Working in this specific area was always my main special interest. I was doing 8 sessions every week, including 1st trimester scan and Nuchal Translucency measurement, 18th to 23rd week anomaly scan, cervical measurement, Uterine and Fetal Dopplers-fetal well being scan. At present I am covering the Early Pregnancy Unit, dealing every day with dating scan and the management of ectopic pregnancies, miscarriages and problems during the very early beginning of the pregnancy. Doing a considerable number of transvaginal scans every day, I achieved a very good experience in scanning the uterus and the adnexa. I was doing every week several invasive procedures (CVS-Amniocentesis). Working in a university teaching hospital, medical students and other trainees – doctor were attached to me, giving me the chance and responsibility to get very important experience in teaching. During my free sessions, I was participating in research projects.

Furthermore, I was doing under supervision -twice weekly- a theater list getting experience in performing ovarian cystectomies, abdominal & vaginal hysterectomies, anterior & posterior colporrhaphies, oophorectomies, cone biopsies etc. I also participate as member of the team in major gynaecological operations (Debulking surgery, Wertheim's hysterectomies, Sacrocolpopexies, Burch & Marshall-Marchetti Colposuspensions, and TVTs). Minor daily cases like ERPCs, drainage & marsupialisation of Bartholin's cysts and hysteroscopies were among my duties.
